I. ABSTRACT (Title Times New Roman, 12 font size, bold)

An abstract is a concise summary of a research paper or entire thesis. It is an original work, not an excerpted passage. An abstract must be fully self-contained and make sense by itself, without further reference to outside sources or to the actual paper.

II. INTRODUCTION (Title Times New Roman, 12 font size, bold)

Current literature regarding the work subject should be examined and the differences of the said work from the past, similar works should be presented clearly in the introduction section.

III. LITERATURE REVIEW

A literature review examines books, academic articles, and other sources pertinent to a certain subject, field of study, or theory, and gives a description, summary, and critical assessment of these works in relevance to the research problem at hand.

IV. DATA

Research data is any information that has been collected, observed, generated or created to validate original research findings. Although usually digital, research data also includes non-digital formats such as laboratory notebooks and diaries.

V. METHODOLOGY

The technique must be presented clearly and thoroughly, with adequate references. The authors shall explain clearly the study topic, the research framework, and the methods used. Additionally, it should be stated why the research question is relevant to theory and practice, as well as why the method(s) chosen are appropriate for the situation.

VI. IMPLICATIONS/RESULTS

Authors must evaluate the research's possible implications for theory or practice and reiterate what the research seeks to contribute to current knowledge on the subject.

VII. REFERENCES

References should be listed in alphabetical order and presented in a commonly accepted format but in a consistent style. The references should follow the American Psychological Association (APA) format. The use of any other referencing format such as the Chicago format with footnotes is not allowed.
